## Services Provided July 2019 through Sept 2019

### SUMMARY

- ✚ 110 individuals received 118 units of service including I/R, consults and training.
- ✚ ASAGA Board and Volunteers provided 12 volunteer hours
- ✚ ASAGA connected with individuals in 14 Alaskan communities and Out of State guardians
- ✚ ASAGA provided one training by request in July 2019 to 14 individuals. ASAGA also offered 8 webinars on a variety of topics. ASAGA's satisfaction rate is over 95% for trainings.
- ✚ We had 2584 visits to our webpage with Education Resources being the top page after Welcome! Through Facebook, we have 342 followers.
