Detail

ASAGA has received \$48,200.00 for FY20 from the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority. We thank them for their generous funding and support of having a guardianship assistance program in Alaska. \$38,560.00 was received in October 2019 and the remaining \$9640.00 will be issued for 4th quarter.

ASAGA continues to hold \$6000 from AARP for the second phase of the video project for translation and is working with the Alaska Court System on parameters. ASAGA's funds equal \$8596.64 at the end of the 2nd quarter.

SUMMARY

- ✚ 260 individuals received 360 units of service including I/R, consults and training.
- ✚ ASAGA Board and Volunteers provided 5 volunteer hours
- ✚ ASAGA connected with individuals in 18 Alaskan communities and Out of State guardians
- ✚ ASAGA hosted two significant events this quarter. In October, we hosted Paul Greenwood, retired elder fraud prosecutor to discuss financial exploitation with 27 participants. November 1st and 2nd was the annual conference with Teepa Snow and Dr. Steven Weisblatt with 111 participants. Both events were streamed via Zoom as well for statewide reach and were very well received. ASAGA also offered six webinars this quarter on Fundamentals of Guardianship and Annual reports. ASAGA's satisfaction rate is over 98% for trainings overall.
- ✚ We had 3828 visits to our webpage with Education Resources being the top page after Welcome followed by Calendar of Events! Through Facebook, we have 346 followers and have reached over 2000 individuals with posts.
